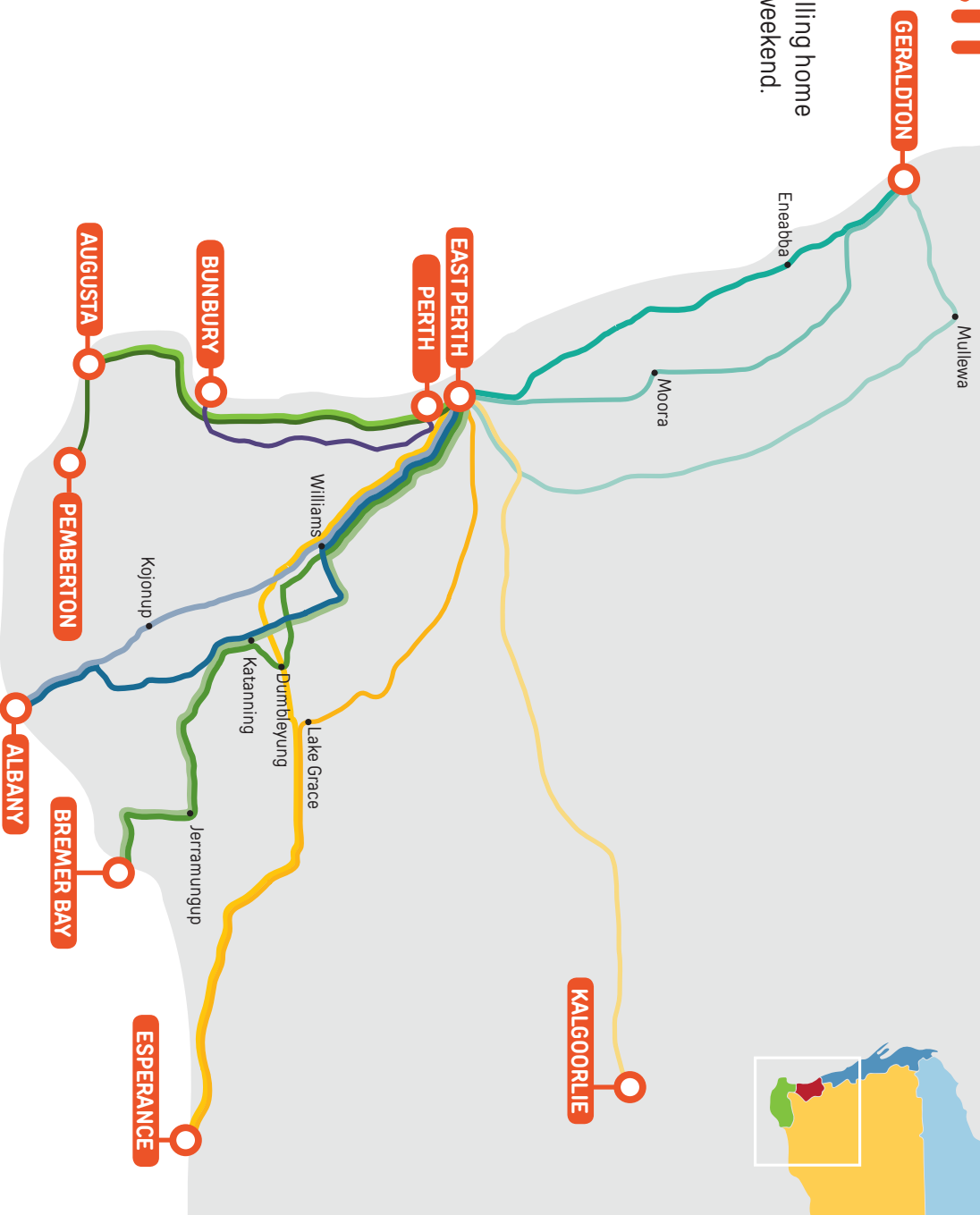

When a student (16 years+) travels with Transwa they are entitled to a 50% concession on all Transwa services. To be eligible for the concession, students must carry a valid Student SmartRider on them at all times. Bookings are accepted online.

Children aged 5 to 15 years (inclusive) are entitled to a 50% concession on all Transwa services. Children aged 10 to 15 years may travel without being accompanied by an adult provided a Travel Authorisation for Unaccompanied Child/Children form has been completed and presented to Transwa staff.

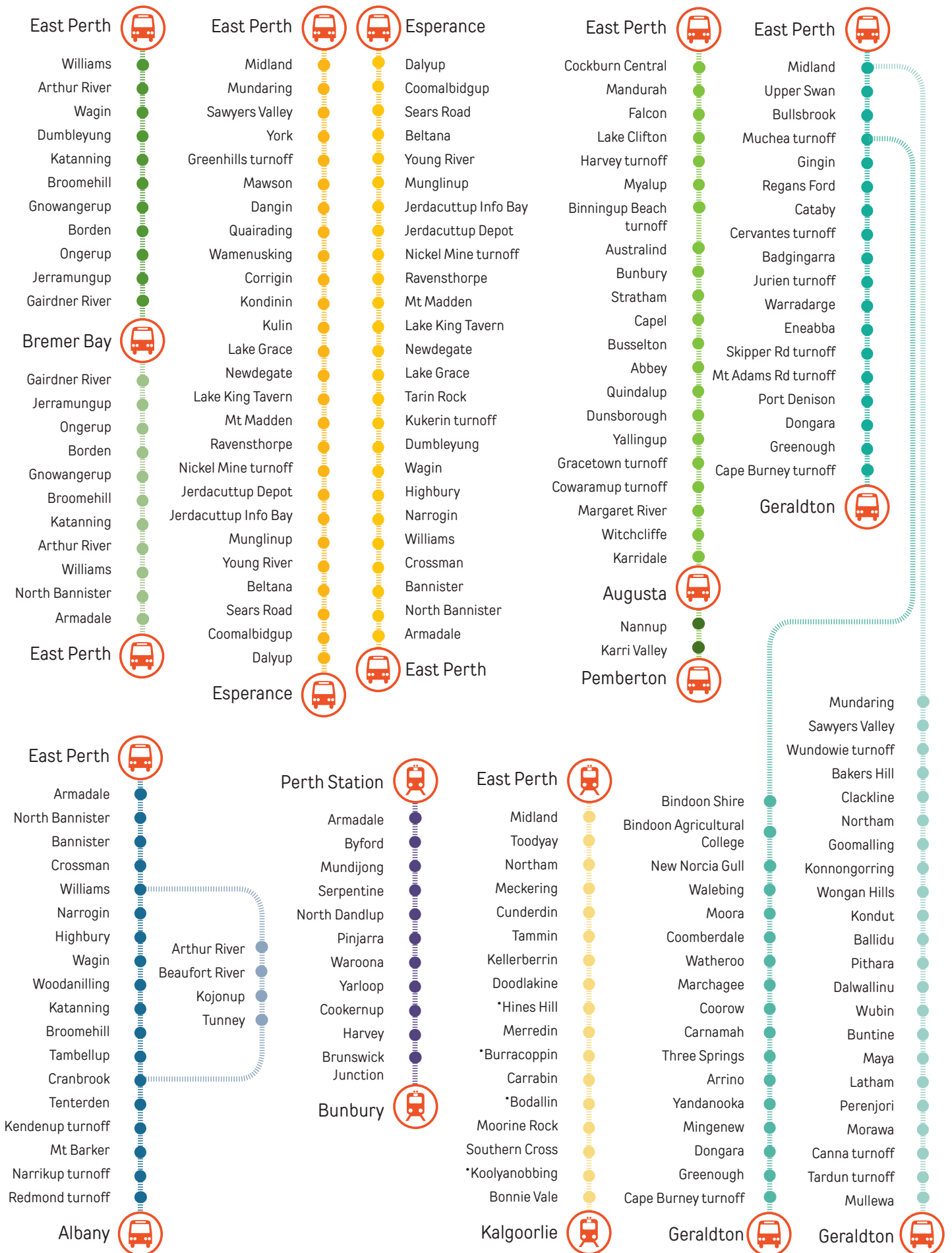
